



COVID-19 TESTING

Frequently Asked Questions

What COVID-19 tests are available?

- ✓ Molecular testing, also referred to as diagnostic, detects the virus and can be used to directly diagnose COVID-19. This test is administered via nasal swabbing.
- ✓ Antibody testing, commonly known as serology, detects antibodies in the blood when the body is fighting an infection. The test does not detect the actual virus; rather, it identifies the body's immune response. This test is administered via finger-stick or venipuncture.

Where can I go to get tested?*

- ✓ Many testing sites require a referral from a primary care provider. If you are showing symptoms or believe you have been exposed, consult with your physician to determine testing necessity.
- ✓ To be tested without a referral, make an appointment with the Florida Department of Health in Marion County by calling (866) 779 – 6121. Starting August 4th, testing will be held at the Livestock Pavilion. Once testing is available at this new location, appointments will not be necessary.

How much does testing cost?***

- ✓ Florida Blue waives all member cost share affiliated with the molecular testing (nasal swabbing) and treatment of COVID-19.
- ✓ Florida Blue will cover FDA/Emergency Use Authorization serology (antibody) tests at \$0 cost share when the following criteria are met:
 - serology tests are ordered by a licensed health care provider
 - the ordering provider has first performed an individual clinical assessment of the member
 - the ordering provider clearly documents in the medical record the reason for the serology test and how the results will impact clinical decision-making.

**Other facilities may offer testing, however, testing procedure and payment process may vary.*

***No payment is required if testing site is in-network with Florida Blue. Employees covered under the MCPS health insurance can contact Angela Hooper at (352) 622-9124 if they were charged a fee for testing.*
